FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT
DATED AUGUST 6, 1976
BETWEEN
THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, N.A., AS AGENT
AND UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, dated August 6, 1976,
between THE CHASE MANHATTAN BANK, N.A., a national banking
association (the "Agent"), and UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY,
a Utah corporation (the "Company"):

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Agent, the Company, and certain manufac-
turers have previously entered into a Conditional Sale Agreement
and Agreement and Assignment, dated as of May 1, 1971 (the "Con-
ditional Sale Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Conditional Sale Agreement was filed and
recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to
Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on August 16, 1971,
and assigned Recordation Nos. 6171-A and 6282; and

WHEREAS, the Agent and the Company desire to execute
and deliver this First Supplemental Agreement for the purpose
of amending the Conditional Sale Agreement to provide for the
substitution of certain railroad equipment for certain of the
Equipment (as that term is defined in the Conditional Sale Agree-
ment) which the Company anticipates may suffer a higher than
normal rate of mechanical failure; and

WHEREAS, the equipment to be substituted for the Equipment has a fair value equal to or in excess of the Casualty Value (as that term is defined in the Conditional Sale Agreement); and

WHEREAS, Article 7 of the Conditional Sale Agreement provides that the Company shall execute, acknowledge, deliver, file, record or deposit all documents (including the filing with the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act of an appropriate supplemental agreement describing such replacements) and do any and all such acts as may be necessary to cause such replacements to come under and be subject to the Conditional Sale Agreement, and to protect the title of the Agent to such replacement units;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, the parties hereto agree that the Conditional Sale Agreement be, and it hereby is, amended as follows:

1. There is hereby deleted from Schedule A to the Conditional Sale Agreement the following reference:


2. There is hereby inserted in Schedule A the following reference:

The Agent shall be entitled to, may exercise, and shall be protected by, to the full extent the same are applicable, all the rights, powers, privileges, immunities and acceptions provided in the Agreement as if provisions concerning the same were incorporated herein at length. The recitals and statements in this First Supplementary Agreement shall be taken as statements of the Company alone.




